NOTICE OF RACE



1 RULES

- 1.1 Club races will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing as amended by the club sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Club races are open to all boats owned by members of HSC
- 2.2 Handicap racing is open to the following classes:
Class 1: all boats with a PN on the RYA National PN list lower than 1200 [Romeo fleet]
Class 2: all boats with a PN on the RYA National PN list greater than 1199 [Zulu fleet]
- 2.3 The handicaps to be used shall be taken from the current RYA National Portsmouth Number list. A copy of this list is available from www.huddersfieldsailing.org.uk/download.html
- 2.4 The Portsmouth Numbers used shall not be adjusted for the duration of an event.

3 FEES

- 3.1 There is no entry fee for members of HSC.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 No registration is required.
- 4.2 The schedule of races is published on the HSC website www.huddersfieldsailing.org.uk/download.html and on the notice board in the clubhouse. The start times are as published in the schedule of races.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A as amended by the club Sailing Instructions will apply.
- 7.2 A boat will be scored in a series if it completes the number of qualifying races specified in the Schedule of Races.
- 7.3 When the qualifying number of races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.4 When more than the qualifying number of races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score(s).

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in races entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £5,000,000 per event.
